- -\$6,000 for three Glendale College Scholarships.
- -\$4,000.00 to the YWCA For the food budget at Camp Rosie, (empowerment and leadership training for girls)
- -\$4,000.00 Glendale Community College Disability Program.
- -\$9,000 to the YWCA Domestic Violence assistance program.

Our charities, YWCA and Glendale College have been invited to our May meeting to receive their donations.

We adopted 220 ducks this year for the Duck Splash netting the Oakmont League \$550! Thank you all so much for supporting all of our charitable causes this year!
